Changes in Equilibrium

What happens to equilibrium output (Y_E) if planned spending increases initially by 100?

Any initial Δ spending results in a much larger ΔY_E because

- 1) Δ spending \rightarrow Δ output
- 2) Δ output $\rightarrow \Delta Y$
- 3) $\Delta Y \rightarrow \Delta YD \rightarrow \Delta C$

Open Economy

Any initial $\Delta spending$ results in a much larger ΔY_E because

- 1) ∆spending → ∆output
- 2) Δ output $\rightarrow \Delta Y$
- 3) $\Delta Y \rightarrow \Delta YD \rightarrow \Delta C$

and $\Delta Y \rightarrow \Delta IM$






Profit-max strategy for buying capital







Credit (or, Financial) Crisis of 2008

- Def: "market failure" permeates financial markets
 - Disequilibrium: Lenders won't lend. No interest rate will clear market.
- Asymmetric information problems in financial markets
 - Adverse selection
 - · Lenders have difficulty assessing riskiness of potential borrowers
 - Moral hazard
 - After signing contract, borrowers may change behavior, increasing risk of default
 - Solutions to asymmetric info problems enable markets to function
