
DBCMP *filename* ;

Function:

DBCMP compresses a TSP databank, removing any wasted space.

Usage:

Follow the word DBCMP with the filename of the TSP databank to be compressed. A copy of the original file is retained with the extension .BAK . Wasted space can be created if variables in a databank are replaced with longer variables (with the same names). Wasted space could also be created if the DBDEL(NOCOMPRESS) command is used. The DBLIST command will mention any wasted space in a databank.

Example:

Suppose that you have a databank called FOO.TLB .

```
DBCMP FOO;
```

would remove any wasted space from FOO.TLB . FOO.BAK is retained, in addition to the compressed FOO.TLB.
