
DBCONV *filename* ;

Function:

DBCONV converts an old TSP 4.1, 4.0 or 3.5 databank to the current databank format. Normally this conversion occurs automatically when an old databank is accessed, if the user has write access to it.

Usage:

Follow the word DBCONV with the filename of the TSP databank to be converted. A copy of the original file is retained with the extension .T41 or .T35 .

Example:

Suppose that you have a TSP 4.0/4.1 format databank called FOO.TLB .

```
DBCONV FOO;
```

would convert it to the current format. FOO.T41 is retained, in addition to the converted FOO.TLB.
